Ingredients

For the meat:

1 pound ground beef 1 teaspoon garlic powder 1 teaspoon onion powder 1 teaspoon paprika 1/2 teaspoon dried oregano 1/2 teaspoon dried basil 1/2 teaspoon dried thyme 1/2 teaspoon black pepper 1/2 teaspoon salt 1/2 teaspoon sugar 2 tablespoons white wine vinegar 1/2 cup evaporated milk 1 (16-inch) pita bread 1/4 cup diced tomato 1/4 cup diced onion 1 head of lettuce

For the Tzatziki Sauce:

1 cup plain Greek yogurt 1/2 medium cucumber, peeled and grated

I clove garlic, minced

1 tablespoon lemon juice

1 tablespoon olive oil

Salt and pepper to taste

Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 375°F.
- 2. In a large bowl, mix together ground beef, garlic powder, onion powder, paprika, oregano, basil, thyme, black pepper, salt, sugar, white wine vinegar, and evaporated milk.
- 3. Shape the mixture into a cylinder and place it on a baking sheet.
- 4. Bake for 35-40 minutes, until browned and cooked through.
- 5. In a separate bowl, mix together the Greek yogurt, grated cucumber, minced garlic, lemon juice, olive oil, salt, and pepper to make the tzatziki sauce.
- 6. Warm the pita bread in the oven or on a stove top griddle.
- 7. To assemble the donair, slice the beef and place it inside the pita bread.
- 8. Top with diced tomato, diced onion, and a generous spoonful of tzatziki sauce.
